## Post-visit Activity: Quick Write Assessment

A favorite Japanese pastime is to make up poetry called Haiku. This 17syllable poem invites students to *describe one simple topic* creatively by following a specific structure:

Line one: 5 syllables

Line two: 7 syllables

Line three: 5 syllables

## Student Samples

Sand scatters the beach	Green and speckled legs,
Waves crash on the sandy shore	Hop on logs and lily pads
Blue water shimmers	Splash in cool water
