## Corrigendum 22 February 2021

Krishnamoorthy et al. (2021) reported Shackelford County as a new county record for the Brazilian Free-tailed Bat (*Tadarida brasiliensis*). However, this species previously was reported from Shackelford County by Lee et al. (2010). This error was an oversight by the authors. Thus, Krishnamoorthy et al. (2021) is not the first to report a record for *T. brasilienis* from Shackelford County, and this corrigendum serves to revise the data reported in Krishnamoorthy et al. (2021) to 61 new county records of mammals in Texas and 34 new county records for *Tadarida brasiliensis*.
