

TTU Distance Education Summer II 2014 Paying-the-Bill Checklist***

- Start checking my TTU email or eBill for my billing statement (First statements on June 12)
- Also beginning April 19, once the student is registered for the term, view student account balance and detail in eBill (www.raiderlink.ttu.edu - choose the “eBill” link in the Student Business Services menu of the Action Items box)
- Submit documentation for waivers, exemptions and third party contracts as early as possible
 - Credits will post to student accounts by June 27 if documentation is received by SBS prior to June 23. Otherwise, credits will post in the order the documentation is received and may take up to 96 hours before the credit is reflected on your student account.
- Review and accept my Financial Aid (www.raiderlink.ttu.edu – click on “View/ Accept Aid Package” in the Student Financial Aid menu of the Action Items box)
- View my aid after it has disbursed to my student account – Disbursement begins June 28 if acceptance of aid and all other requirements have been met by student
- Verify my account to make sure all applicable waivers, exemptions and third party credits have posted to my account
- Pay my account in full or enroll in a payment plan (www.raiderlink.ttu.edu – choose the “eBill” link in the Student Business Services menu of the Action Items box)
 - **Summer II payment due date is July 1, 2014** – Failure to meet this date may result in the cancellation of my registration and the addition of late fees to my account
 - **HSC/TTU/Law dual-enrolled students must pay each campus term separately**
- Give my parent or bill payer authorization to receive notifications via email and view/pay my bill online (www.raiderlink.ttu.edu, click on “eBill” link in the Student Business Services menu of the Action Items box then choose “Authorized Users”)
- Make sure I have a FERPA form on file to allow TTU representatives to speak with my parent or bill payer should the need arise (<http://www.depts.ttu.edu/registrar/FERPA/FERPAWaiverForm.pdf>)
- **Sign up for My Direct Deposit to get my refund fast** (www.raiderlink.ttu.edu, choose the “My Direct Deposit” link in the Student Business Services menu of the Action Items box)
- Buy books - Book loans available June 27 through July 18 at sbsbookloans.ttu.edu

***Non-resident students who reside outside the state of Texas are not subject to state tuition and are not eligible for state waivers and exemptions. However, they are subject to Non-Resident, Distance Education (NRDE) tuition at a current rate of \$50/SCH which is equal to that of state tuition for resident students. This rate is subject to change prior to billing for any term at the discretion of the Provost office.
