Senate Resolution 41.11

(Stating the sentiments of the Student Senate concerning the addition of a leisure pool to the Robert H. Ewalt Student Recreation Center)

WHEREAS, the addition of an outdoor leisure pool would complete the final stage of the recent renovation to the student recreation center, and

WHEREAS, a leisure pool would promote community between Tech students, faculty and staff, and

WHEREAS, the removal and assembly of the air supported roof, has become a safety issue for student workers as well as recreation sports staff, and

WHEREAS, a leisure pool would provide the opportunity for a longer outdoor swim season, and

WHEREAS, the opportunity for interaction between fellow students would foster positive relationships and ensure the prominence of Texas Tech Recreational Center.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Texas Tech Student Senate supports a new leisure pool addition to the Student Recreation Center, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the student recreation fees do not increase until the completion of the leisure pool, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that with the addition of the leisure pool, a permanent roof and cooling system be added to the existing aquatic center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be spread upon the Journal and that copies be sent to Dr. Jon Whitmore, President of Texas Tech University; Dr. Michael Shonrock, Vice President of Student Affairs; Joe MacLean, Director of RecSports; Joey Kirk, Editor of *The Daily Toreador*; and to the students of Texas Tech University.
