(Stating the sentiments of the Student Senate concerning traffic controls on Flint Avenue)

WHEREAS, currently, buses stop along Flint Avenue across from the Business Administration Building, and

WHEREAS, this congestion causes danger for both pedestrians and drivers, and

WHEREAS, bus turnouts, and controlled crosswalks would allow for a smoother flow of traffic.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Student Senate requests that bus turn-outs, as well as light controlled crosswalks be constructed on Flint Avenue, in front of the Business Administration building to ensure the immediate safety of both pedestrians and drivers, and
