(Stating the sentiments of the Student Senate concerning a four way stop at the 15<sup>th</sup> and Akron intersection)

WHEREAS, currently, the 15<sup>th</sup> and Akron intersection is controlled by only two stop signs, and

WHEREAS, this is a major intersection on campus, which is used by the majority of bus routes on campus and off, and

WHEREAS, making this intersection a four way stop would greatly reduce traffic congestion, confusion, and safety concerns.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a four way stop intersection be constructed on the 15<sup>th</sup> and Akron intersection, and
