

Cottonseed receipts at oil mills in the western states continued to decline during the week ended January 27, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Harvesting of the cotton crop is virtually completed. Oil mill receipts are mostly from gins with moduled seed cotton. Demand for cottonseed products remained fairly good. Cottonseed grade certificates received from licensed chemists declined to 921 compared with 1,141 a week earlier.

Growers received \$50.00 to \$100.00 per ton for cottonseed at the gin, unchanged since mid-November. Average prices in the western states ranged from \$71.20 per ton in Arizona to \$85.00 in New Mexico. Oil mills paid ginners \$80.00 to \$90.00 per ton, basis grade 100 and \$74.00 to \$95.00 per ton for seed "as is". Some prices quoted represented advances to both growers and ginners. Wholesale prices for bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$115.00 to \$190.00 per ton. Sacked meal was quoted at \$176.00 to \$210.00 per on. Bulk hull prices were \$15.00 to \$50.00 per ton and sacked hulls \$60.00 to \$75.00 per ton.

Cottonseed receipts at oil mills in the western states continued to slacken during the week ended January 20, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Many gins have completed operations this season and those remaining open are ginning mostly from moduled seed cotton. Cottonseed grade certificates received from licensed chemists totaled 1,141 this week compared with 1,807 a week earlier.

Growers received \$50.00 to \$100.00 per ton for cottonseed at the gin. Average prices in the western states ranged from \$73.70 per ton in Arizona to \$88.20 in California. Oil mills paid ginners \$80.00 to \$90.00 per ton, basis grade 100 and \$74.00 to \$95.00 per ton for seed "as is". Some prices quoted represented advances to both growers and ginners. Wholesale prices for bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$115.00 to \$190.00 per ton. Sacked meal was quoted at \$176.00 to \$210.00 per ton. Bulk hull prices were \$15.00 to \$50.00 per ton and sacked hulls \$55.00 to \$80.00 per ton.

Oil mills in the western states continued crushing cottonseed but receipts from gins declined as harvesting reached advanced stages during the week ending January 13, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Demand for cottonseed products remained good. Adverse weather conditions slowed final stages of harvesting and movement of cottonseed to mills in many localities. Cottonseed grade certificates received from licensed chemists totaled 1,807 this week compared with 2,768 during the previous two-week period.

Growers received \$50.00 to \$100.00 per ton for cottonseed at the gin. Oil mills paid ginners \$80.00 to \$90.00 per ton, basis grade 100 and \$74.00 to \$95.00 per ton for seed "as is". Some prices quoted represented advances to both growers and ginners. Wholesale prices for bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$115.00 to \$185.00 per ton. Sacked meal was quoted at \$176.00 to \$210.00 per ton. Bulk hull prices were \$15.00 to \$55.00 per ton and sacked hulls \$55.00 to \$85.00 per ton.

Cottonseed production based on a three year average lint seed ratio, is estimated at 6.25 million tons, 40 percent above 1980 production, according to the Crop Reporting Board, SRS, USDA.

Cotton production in the United States is estimated at 15.7 million 480 pound net weight bales, up one percent from the December 1 forecast and 41 percent above production in 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board, SRS, USDA. Upland production is estimated at 15.6 million bales and American Pima at 90,400 bales.



Movement of cottonseed to oil mills in the western states declined during the two-week period ended January 6, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Harvest reached final stages but some field stored cotton remains to be ginned. Most of the expected volume of cottonseed has entered oil mills. Cottonseed grade certificates received from licensed chemists totaled 2,768 for the period.

Growers received \$50.00 to \$100.00 per ton for cottonseed at the gin. oil mills paid ginners \$80.00 to \$90.00 per ton, basis grade 100 and \$74.00 to \$95.00 per ton for seed "as is". Some prices quoted represented advances to both growers and ginners. Wholesale prices for bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$115.00 to \$185.00 per ton. Sacked meal was quoted at \$175.00 to \$210.00 per ton. Bulk hull prices were \$10.00 to \$5.00 per ton and sacked hulls \$55.00 to \$85.00 per ton.

Cottonseed moved to oil mills at a slow pace in western states, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Much of the current ginning is from seed cotton stored in ricks or modules. Grade certificates received totaled 1,801 this week compared with 2,104 a week earlier.

Fices paid growers for cottonseed ranged from \$50.00 to \$100.00 per ton, unchanged from st week. Oil mills paid ginners \$80.00 to \$90.00 per ton, basis grade 100 and \$74.00 to \$95.00 "as is". Some prices quoted represented advances to both growers and ginners. Wholesale prices for bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$115.00 to \$176.00 per ton and sacked meal from \$175.00 to \$193.00 per ton. Hull prices ranged from \$10.00 to \$60.00 per ton bulk and \$55.00 to \$85.00 per ton sacked.

Cottonseed production, based on a three year average lint-seed ratio, is forecast at 6.19 llion tons compared with 4.47 million tons produced in 1980, according to the Crop Reting Board, SRS, USDA.

Cotton production in the United States is forecast at 15.6 million 480 pound net weight bales, virtually the same as last month's forecast but 40 percent more than production in 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board, SRS, USDA. Upland production is expected to total 15.5 million bales and American Pima 93,200 bales.

Cottonseed moved to oil mills in the western states at a moderate rate during the week ending December 16, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Showers received in portions of the Texas Plains caused a slight drop in volume of receipts. Demand for cottonseed meal continued strong. Harvesting neared completion in many localities, was past three-fourths completed on the Texas Plains and over one-half empleted in Oklahoma. Cottonseed grade certificates received from licensed chemists durge the week totaled 2,104 compared with 2,176 last week.

Growers received \$50.00 to \$100.00 per ton for cottonseed at the gin, unchanged from a week earlier. Oil mills paid ginners \$80.00 to \$95.00 per ton, basis grade 100 and \$74.00 to \$95.00 per ton for seed "as is". Some prices quoted represented advances to both growers and ginners. Wholesale prices for bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$115.00 to \$176.00 per ton. Sacked meal was quoted at \$171.00 to \$193.00 per ton. Bulk 11 prices were \$10.00 to \$60.00 per ton and sacked hulls \$44.00 to \$85.00 per ton.



Cottonseed receipts at oil mills in western states remained steady during the week ending December 9, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Receipts were heaviest in Oklahoma and on the Texas Plains where harvesting continued at a rapid pace. Harvesting was virtually completed over most of the remaining Cotton Belt. Demand increased first livestock feeders for cottonseed meal. Cottonseed grade certificates received from liced chemists during the week totaled 2,176.

Ginners paid growers \$50.00 to \$100.00 per ton for cottonseed at the gin. Average prices in the western states ranged from \$74.60 per ton in Arizona to \$89.60 in California. Oil mills paid ginners \$85.00 to \$90.00 per ton, basis grade 100 and \$74.00 to \$95.00 per ton for seed "as is". Some prices quoted represented advances to both growers and ginners. Wholesale prices for bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$115.00 to \$176.00 per ton. Sacked meal was quoted at \$171.00 to \$193.00 per ton. Bulk hull prices were \$10.00 to \$60.00 ton and sacked hulls \$64.00 to \$85.00 per ton.

Cottonseed moved to oil mills at a rapid pace in western states during the two week period ending December 2, 1981. Southern states oil mills remained active in crushing seed but seed receipts from gins slowed significantly as harvesting reached advanced stages, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Harvesting slowed in California, remained active in Arizona and New Mexico and reached peak proportions in the Texas-Oklahoma Plains. Cottonseed grade certificates received from licensed chemists totaled 5,912 for the two week period.

thern states: Growers received \$64.00 to \$105.00 per ton for cottonseed at the gin, about unchanged from two weeks earlier. Oil mills paid ginners \$85.00 to \$100.00 per ton, basis grade 100, unchanged from the previous report. Wholesale prices for 41 percent bulk protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$145.00 to \$205.00 per ton. Sacked meal was quoted at \$170.00 to \$220.00 per ton. Bulk hulls traded at \$25.00 to \$70.00 per ton and sacked hull prices ranged from \$50.00 to \$95.00. This will be the last week this season that southern states will be included in the Cottonseed Review due to the advanced stage of harvesting.

Cottonseed moved to oil mills in heavier volume in western states as the harvest picked up speed. Harvesting neared completion in southern states during the week ended November 18, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Harvesting was at near peak levels in California and Arizona. A killing frost was received in portions of the Texas Plains and Oklahoma. Cottonseed grade certificates totaled 3,529 compared with 2,315 last we-1.

Southern states: Prices paid growers were about unchanged and ranged from \$64.00 to \$105.00 per ton at the gin. Oil mills paid ginners \$85.00 to \$100.00 per ton, basis grade 100, the same as a week earlier. Wholesale prices for sacked 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$170.00 to \$220.00 per ton compared with \$165.00 to \$220.00 per ton last week. Bulk hulls were quoted from \$25.00 to \$75.00 per ton and sacked hulls from \$45.00 to \$100.00.

We tern states: Grower prices for cottonseed ranged from \$50.00 to \$100.00 per ton. Some represented an advance to growers with final settlement at a later date. Oil mills paid ginners \$85.00 to \$90.00 per ton, basis grade 100. Wholesale prices for bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$115.00 to \$176.00 per ton. Sacked meal prices varied from \$167.00 to \$193.00 per ton. Bulk hull prices ranged from \$7.00 to \$80.00 per ton and sacked hulls from \$72.00 to \$105.00 per ton.

Cottonseed receipts tapered off in south central and southeastern states and increased in Texas during the period ended November 10, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Rain delayed picking in some localities of the belt. Harvesting moved past the three-fourths point in south central and southeastern states, expanded in the Texas Plains, was underway in Oklahoma, New Mexico and Arizona and gained momentum in California. Cottonseed grade certificates totaled 2,315 during the period compared with 2,314 last week.

Southern states: Prices received by growers were fairly steady and ranged from \$64.00 to \$110.00 per ton at the gin. Oil mills paid ginners \$85.00 to \$100.00 per ton for seed, basis grade 100, unchanged from a week earlier. Wholesale prices for sacked 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$165.00 to \$220.00 per ton and \$145.00 to \$200.00 per ton bulk. Prices for bulk hulls varied from \$29.00 to \$70.00 per ton and \$55.00 to \$95.00 sacked.

Western states: Growers received \$50.00 to \$95.00 per ton for cottonseed. Some prices repreted an advance to growers with final settlement at a later date. Oil mills paid gins .00 to \$95.00 per ton, basis grade 100. Wholesale prices for bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal were \$115.00 to \$176.00 per ton and \$167.00 to \$193.00 per ton sacked. Bulk hull prices varied from \$15.00 to \$90.00 per ton and sacked hulls ranged from \$72.00 to \$105.00.

Cottonseed movement to oil mills increased during the week ending October 28, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Ginning continued at an active pace despite rains in many localities. Stored seed cotton supplies permitted gins to operate where picking was interrupted. Grade certificates received from licensed cottonseed chemists during the week totaled 2,700 - up from 2,521 a week earlier.

Southern states: Prices paid to growers for cottonseed remained steady and ranged from \$68.00 \$105.00 per ton. Producers received mostly \$70.00 to \$90.00 per ton. Oil mills paid gins \$2.00 to \$100.00 per ton, mostly \$85.00 to \$90.00, basis grade 100. A few gins in Georgia sold a limited volume of seed to livestock feeders at around \$120.00 per ton. Wholesale prices for 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$145.00 to \$185.00 per ton bulk and \$165.00 to \$220.00 sacked. Hull prices ranged from \$35.00 to \$70.00 per ton bulk and \$58.00 to \$100.00 sacked.

Western states: Growers received \$50.00 to \$105.00 per ton for cottonseed. These prices inluded "advances" at some Arizona and California gins. Oil mills paid ginners \$85.00 to \$95.00 r ton, basis grade 100 and \$74.00 to \$85.00 per ton "as is". This range also included advances and final settlement will be made later. Wholesale prices for 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$133.00 to \$176.00 per ton bulk and \$175.00 to \$195.00 sacked. Hull prices ranged from \$18.00 to \$90.00 per ton bulk and \$75.00 to \$110.00 sacked. Some cottonseed hulls moved to oil drilling contractors in west Texas.



Cottonseed continued to move to oil mills at a heavy rate during the week ended October 21, but slowed a little from a week earlier, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Receipts were heaviest in localities where harvesting was most active. Ginning moved ahead rapidly in southern states although rain interrupted picking in some localities. Harvesting was completed in south and portions of central Texas and was getting underway elsewhere in the state. In the Far Western states, harvesting was gaining momentum. Grade certificates received during the period totaled 2,521 compared with 3,172 last week.

Southern states: Prices paid growers for cottonseed at the gin were fairly steady and ranged from \$60.00 to \$105.00 per ton. Oil mills paid ginners \$85.00 to \$100.00 per ton, basis grade 100, about the same as a week earlier. Wholesale prices for sacked 41 percent protein cottonseed meal were down slightly and ranged from \$165.00 to \$215.00 per ton. Bulk meal traded from \$145.00 to \$195.00 per ton. Hull prices varied from \$35.00 to \$70.00 per ton bulk and \$60.00 to \$95.00 per ton sacked.

Western states: Cottonseed prices ranged from \$64.00 to \$100.00 per ton. Grower prices established at some California and Arizona gin points represent an advance with settlement to be made at a later date. Oil mills paid ginners \$85.00 to \$95.00 per ton, basis grade 100, and \$74.00 to \$95.00 per ton "as is". Wholesale prices for 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$170.00 to \$195.00 per ton sacked and from \$130.00 to \$176.00 per ton bulk, about unchanged from last week. Bulk hull prices were quoted at \$18.00 to \$90.00 per ton, the same as a week ago. Sacked hulls brought \$75.00 to \$110.00.

Cottonseed arrived at oil mills at a steady rate during the week ended October 14, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Cotton harvesting gained momentum in the Far West but was delayed by rain in some central and southeastern states. Cottonseed prices trended lower. Grade certificates received during the period totaled 3,172 compared to 3,130 last week.

<u>states</u>: Prices received by growers were slightly lower and ranged from \$64.00 to \$100.00 per ton at the gin. Oil mills paid ginners \$80.00 to \$100.00 per ton for seed, basis grade 100, mostly \$80.00 to \$90.00. Wholesale prices for sacked 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$170.00 to \$230.00 per ton, with bulk meal bringing \$145.00 to \$200.00. Prices for bulk hulls ranged from \$35.00 to \$70.00 per ton, mostly \$45.00 to \$60.00. Sacked hulls traded from \$70.00 to \$95.00 per ton.

Western states: Grower prices for cottonseed ranged from \$50.00 to \$100.00 per ton. Some ices represented an advance to growers with final settlement at a later date. Oil mills id ginners \$90.00 to \$95.00 per ton, basis grade 100 and \$85.00 to \$90.00 per ton on an "as is" basis. Wholesale prices for bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$135.00 to \$176.00 per ton. Sacked meal was \$175.00 to \$195.00 per ton. Cottonseed receipts at oil mills increased during the week ended October 7, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Cotton harvesting progressed rapidly in southern states and in central Texas and was moving slowly in the Far West. Grade certificates received during the period totaled 3,130 compared to 2,147 last week.

Southern states: Prices paid growers for cottonseed were steady to slightly lower and ranged from \$72.00 to \$105.00 per ton at the gin. Oil mills paid ginners \$80.00 to \$100.00 per ton, is grade 100, mostly \$90.00 to \$95.00. Wholesale prices for sacked, 41 percent protein in all ranged from \$155.00 to \$230.00 per ton with bulk meal bringing \$135.00 to \$210.00. Prices for bulk hulls varied from \$35.00 to \$80.00 per ton with sacked hulls trading from \$55.00 to \$100.00.

Western states: Grower prices for cottonseed ranged mostly from \$50.00 to \$105.00 per ton. Oil mills paid ginners \$90.00 per ton basis grade 100. Wholesale prices for sacked, 41 percent protein meal ranged from \$178.00 to \$195.00 per ton. Bulk meal was quoted at \$140.00 to \$176.00 per ton. Bulk hulls were bringing \$20.00 to \$90.00 per ton. Sacked hull prices rangfrom \$81.00 to \$105.00 per ton.

cottonseed: Oil mills received 133,000 tons of cottonseed during August. This was the largest August receipts since 1978 and compares with 10,000 tons in July and 84,000 tons in August last season. Mills crushed 177,000 tons of cottonseed in August, the smallest August crushings since 1976 and down from 218,000 tons in July and 330,000 tons in August 1980. Oil mills had 353,000 tons of cottonseed on hand at the end of August compared with 398,000 tons a month earlier and 812,000 tons a year ago.



Cottonseed grade certificates totaled 2,147 compared with 719 last week.

wern states: Ginners paid Texas growers from \$65.00 to \$110.00 per ton for cottonseed at the gin. Oil mills paid ginners \$90.00 to \$110.00 per ton basis grade 100. Wholesale prices for bulk cottonseed meal, 41 percent protein, ranged from \$160.00 to \$183.00 per ton. Sacked meal prices ranged from \$178.00 to \$200.00. Bulk hulls varied in price from \$50.00 to \$80.00 and sacked hulls traded from \$85.00 to \$105.00 per ton.

Southern states: Ginners in southern states paid growers \$76.00 to \$100.00 per ton for cottonseed. Oil mills paid ginners \$90.00 to \$105.00 per ton basis grade 100. Wholesale prices sacked, 41 percent protein, cottonseed meal ranged from \$155.00 to \$230.00 per ton with meal bringing \$133.00 to \$215.00. Prices for bulk hulls varied from \$45.00 to \$100.00 per ton with sacked hulls selling from \$65.00 to \$125.00.

Movement of cottonseed dropped off in south Texas as the harvest neared completion in the Harlingen area but remained fairly heavy in central Texas despite recent rains, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Harvesting gained momentum in south central and southeastern states, made a slow start in the El Centro area and was underway in Arizona. Cottonseed certificates totaled 719 this week against 679 received last week.

Cottonseed prices paid to Texas growers were fairly steady and ranged from \$85.00 to \$110.00 per ton against \$83.00 to \$100.00 per ton last week. Prices paid gins by oil mills were unchanged at \$100.00 to \$110.00 per ton, basis grade 100. Cottonseed grades ranged from 70.0 to 104.0 in Corpus Christi, 72.5 to 105.0 in Harlingen and 70.0 to 101.0 in Austin. Wholesale prices for sacked 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$178.00 to \$198.00 per ton, unchanged from the previous week. Bulk meal traded from \$160.00 to \$190.00 per ton, up slightly from a week earlier. Bulk hulls traded from \$50.00 to \$68.00, up slightly from last week and sacked hulls sold for around \$80.00 to \$89.00 per ton.

Mississippi growers received \$80.00 to \$100.00 per ton for cottonseed at the gin. Oil mills paid ginners \$100.00 per ton, basis grade 100. Bulk 41 percent protein cottonseed meal sold from \$153.00 to \$165.00 per ton, down slightly from last week. Sacked meal traded from \$178.00 to \$195.00 per ton, also down from the previous week. Hull prices were about unchanged and ranged from \$47.00 to \$98.00 per ton in bulk and \$80.00 to \$128.00 sacked.

Only a few gins remained in operation in south Texas as harvesting was virtually completed, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Gins operated from cotton stored in modules or waiting on gin yards. Harvesting was slowed by unfavorable weather in the Upper Coastal Bend and Austin territories and made a slow start in Mississippi Delta states. Crop maturity and early picking was delayed by rain in south central and southeastern states. Cottonseed certificates totaled 679 this week against 318 received last week.

Cottonseed prices paid to Texas growers were steady and ranged from \$83.00 to \$100.00 per ton. Prices paid gins by oil mills were unchanged at \$100.00 to \$110.00 per ton, basis grade 100. Cottonseed grades ranged from 72.5 to 107.5 in Corpus Christi, 72.5 to 104.5 in Harlingen and 81.5 to 110.0 in Austin. Wholesale prices for sacked 41 percent protein cottonseed meal ranged from \$178.00 to \$198.00 per ton and bulk meal from \$160.00 to \$177.00. Bulk hulls traded from \$50.00 to \$60.00 per ton and sacked hulls at around \$90.00 per ton.

Mississippi Delta growers received \$90.00 to \$100.00 per ton for cottonseed at the gin. Oil mills paid ginners \$100.00 per ton basis grade 100. Bulk 41 percent protein meal prices varied from \$150.00 to \$175.00 and sacked meal from \$190.00 to \$205.00 per ton. Hull prices ranged from \$55.00 to \$90.00 in bulk and \$80.00 to \$120.00 per ton sacked.

Movement of cottonseed to Texas oil mills slowed due to heavy rains and wet fields, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Harvesting neared completion in the Corpus Christi and Harlingen areas. Much of current ginnings was from stored seed cotton. First bales have been ginned in most other states but general harvesting is still a few weeks away. Defoliants were applied to a large number of acres in southern and southeastern states. Cottonseed grade certificates received totaled 318 this week.

Prices paid growers for cottonseed ranged generally from \$84.00 to \$95.00 per ton in Texas on an "as-is" basis. Oil mills paid ginners \$100.00 to \$110.00 per ton for seed basis grade 100. Cottonseed grades ranged from 72.5 to 107.5 in Corpus Christi, 78.0 to 103.0 in Harlingen and 85.5 to 110.0 in Austin. Wholesale prices for 41 percent protein cottonseed meal were up slightly from last week and varied from \$178.00 to \$208.00 per ton sacked and from \$160.00 to \$187.00 per ton bulk. Bulk hulls traded from \$50.00 to \$68.00.



Movement of cottonseed to south Texas oil mills slowed during the week ended September 2, according to the Cotton Division, Agricultural Marketing Service, USDA. Before recent rains, picking was gaining momentum in the Upper Coastal Bend, was well advanced in the Coastal Bend and neared completion in the Harlingen territory. This is the first Cottonseed Review of the 1981-82 season and will be followed with periodic reports during active cotton harvesting.

Cottonseed prices paid to growers ranged generally from \$85.00 to \$100.00 per ton on an "as-is basis." Oil mills paid ginners \$100.00 per ton basis grade 100. Cottonseed grades ranged for 71.5 to 108.5 in the Corpus Christi area, 85.0 to 107.0 in the Harlingen area and 66.5 to 107.5 in the Austin area. Wholesale prices for sacked 41 percent protein cottonseed meal varied for \$173.00 to \$185.00 per ton. Bulk meal prices ranged from \$155.00 to \$165.00 per ton. Bulk hulls traded from \$50.00 to \$59.00 and sacked hulls from \$70.00 to \$80.00 per ton.
