### Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton consumed during the month ending December 31, 1997, amounted to 953,893 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of December was 562,379 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 11,937,903 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles totaled 2,615,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 804,800 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(97)-12", dated January 22, 1998.

Estimates are All Cotton ginned prior to February 1, 1998.
