





Fall 2018 Projections


- Texas Tech University is on track to have another record breaking year of enrollment.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Required Application Items

- ApplyTexas application
- \$75 application fee / waiver
- Official transcripts*
- Official SAT/ACT scores

The Fall 2018 application opened July 1, 2017.
Notification takes 2-4 weeks.

*Submit high school transcripts using the uploader in [RaiderConnect](#) or by US mail (Box 45005, Lubbock, TX 79409). High schools can send it directly to us through TReX.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

New Transcript Policy

Applicants will be allowed to upload their documents as .pdf files

- Essays, Letters of Recommendation AND Transcripts
- Only for use in the admissions process
- Final transcript must come from the school or their agent

Counselors will be able to upload transcripts as .pdf files

- Using Counselor Portal on our website
- Files size up to 35 MB (200, 4-page transcripts)
- Used for application documents and final high school transcripts





ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Application Fee Waivers

Applicant must be:

- United States Citizen
- (or) Permanent Resident
- (or) SB 1528 Texas Resident

Applicant must also display financial hardship:

- Income Verification FAFSA
- (or) Submit Fee Waiver Request Form
 - 2016 Income Tax Form – Page 1
 - Documentation of subsidized housing, foster home, homelessness, public assistance, ward of the state or orphan.

Fourth Quarter	Application Review	

Assured Admission is required for all biological sciences, business, engineering, interior design, physics and astronomy. Engineering applicants who do not meet the assured admission requirement will be placed in pre-engineering.

Transfer Admission guarantees admission into Texas Tech University. Some majors and colleges have a higher GPA requirement for admission, including Architecture, Biological Sciences, Business, Engineering, Honors, Human Development & Family Studies, Interior Design and Kinesiology.

If YES - Amount is based on test score...	Amount (per year)	*Renewal Requirements*
SAT 1500+ (or ACT 34)	\$8,500	3.5 GPA & 30 earned hours per year


