Description

A student whose adjusted GPA is below 2.0 will be placed on Academic Probation. Students on Probation may not enroll in more than 16 hours without prior approval of their academic dean. In addition, Probation students must seek regularly scheduled advising from an academic advisor or the dean. Enrollment in XL 0201 - Strategies for Learning may be required of students on Academic Probation.

Objectives

By the end of this semester, you should be able to:

- Take positive steps toward restoring Academic Good Standing with the University
- Openly and honestly discuss your academic progress with all invested parties
- To modify behaviors that have contributed to your current Probation status, adding successful behaviors that you have not exhibited

Policies

Appointments: ACTT strongly suggests students on Academic Probation schedule a monthly appointment with their advisor.

Communication: Your Advisor as a Resource
Keep your advisor informed about any circumstances that could influence your academic performance such as work schedules, illness, family, or other personal situations.

Expectations: **Students** are expected to be active, invested, and responsible participants in the advising process with the following behavior:

- Go to Class !
- Keep advisors informed about any circumstances that could influence academic performance such as work schedules, illness, family, or other personal situations.
- Notify advisors immediately when a course grade of D or F is received.

Advisors are expected to serve as a resources and counselors for students on Probation as well as the following:

- Provide students with a caring person who may serve as a role model throughout their college experience
- Provide students with accurate information concerning academic policies and procedures

Semester Calendar

Week 1: August 28 – September 3

Aug. 29, Monday: Classes begin.

August 31st, Thursday: Make an appointment to meet with your Academic Advisor - plan on scheduling one for each month of the academic semester..

Week 2: September 4 – 10

Sept. 4, Monday: TTU is closed to observe the Labor Day Holiday.

During this week: Meet with your Academic Advisor to discuss the courses for which you are enrolled

Week 3: September 11 – 17

Sept. 13, Wednesday: If you feel a class is not working for you, this is your last chance to drop a class. Drop online ends on Wednesday, September 13. Check with your academic advisor.

Week 4: September 18 – 24

Meet with your Academic Advisor to discuss your semester.

Week 5: September 25 – October 1

Sept. 25, Monday: The calm before the storm. Make sure you are caught up in ALL your classes.

Week 6: October 2 – 8

October is traditionally a busy test month in most classes. Study and stop by to discuss your grades with your Academic Advisor.

Week 7: October 9 – 15

Oct 9, Monday If you have not already learned about the registration process, check in with your advisor. Registration for Spring 2007 is coming up.

Week 8: October 16 – 20

Oct. 16, Monday: **WOW, mid-semester has arrived!**
Plan your week differently than a week when you are just attending classes.

Week 9: October 23-27

Make sure you have made and kept your October appointment with your Academic Advisor

Week 10: October 30 – November 5

Oct. 30, Monday: Last day to drop a course, transfer between colleges, or withdraw from the university. Regroup from mid terms. Refocus. Use your advisor to help you plan your last 4 weeks to even better support your last month of classes.

Week 11: November 6 – 12

Nov. 6 – 21, Monday – Tuesday: Registration for Spring 2007 begins for currently enrolled students. Students should contact their academic advisor for assistance.

Week 12: November 13 – 19

Nov. 13, Monday: Meet with your Academic Advisor prior to Thanksgiving Holidays .

Week 13: November 20 – 26

Nov. 22 – 26, Wed. – Sunday: Thanksgiving Holiday.

Week 14: November 27 – December 3

Nov. 27, Monday: Classes resume after the Thanksgiving holiday.
Open registration for Spring 07 begins.
