Summary

Requirements

A student that has multi-disciplinary pursuits in academics, work, activities, or volunteer work preferred but not a prerequisite.

Requirements

- Junior or above in class rank
- 3.3 or higher GPA

3. What do you hope to accomplish with your life? (include community service and church work)
4. Add any information about yourself that you feel is important for scholarship selection.
5. Use this essay to let the scholarship committee know what type of person you are and why you deserve this award.

Each applicant must include the following with the application:

1. Official, sealed school transcript.
2. Two letters of recommendation from school personnel who know your work.
