- Three Awards: One each in Humanities, Social Sciences and Natural and Physical Sciences
- Eligibility: tenured and tenure-track faculty and full-time research faculty: can be awarded every five years to the same individual

Dossier Requirements (20-page total)

- Completed nomination form not to be counted in the 20-page total.
- Nomination letter by the Chair of Department
- Research statement highlighting the nominee's substantial research or scholarship **accomplishments** and its **impact** and **significance**, covering a three year period at TTU is required. Listing of internal TTU research award as basis for nomination without the requisite documentation is insufficient for consideration for this award (**research** statement not to exceed 1 page).
- Letters from colleagues, focusing on the criteria for this award (not to exceed 3 letters and each letter should not exceed 1 page).
- Nominee's curriculum vitae supporting research and scholarship accomplishments
- Optional support materials that document excellence in the area under consideration for the award. Any optional materials exceeding the 20-page limit will not be considered.

Awardees will be notified by the end of the fall semester with the official recognition occurring at the spring Arts & Sciences Lubbock Alumni Reception. - Letters from colleagues or students, focusing on the criteria for this award (not to exceed 3 letters and each letter should not exceed 1 page).
- Nominee's curriculum vitae
- Optional support materials that document excellence in the area under consideration for the award. Any optional materials exceeding the 20-page limit will not be considered.

- Letters from colleagues or students, focusing on the criteria for this award (not to exceed 3 letters and each letter should not exceed 1 page).
- Nominee's curriculum vitae
- Optional support materials that document excellence in the area under consideration for the award. Any optional materials exceeding the 20-page limit will not be considered.
