Minor corrections/revisions were made to the course approval form at the meeting, but ASCAP requests that the proposed shortened title be reconsidered, to provide one with more clarity and usability. The proposal will be held pending a response from the department.

In other business, committee briefly discussed its upcoming visit (January 31) with the *Phi Beta Kappa* site visit team. A couple of members will be unable to participate in that visit due to schedule conflicts, but it appears a quorum will be present.
