5. LING 5355 Teaching English in International Contexts, *Proposed new course*  
Recommendation offered for wording syllabus
6. PHIL 3323 Introduction to Business Ethics, *Proposed new course*  
Accepted as presented
7. PHIL 5323 Business Ethics, *Proposed new course*  
Accepted as presented
