Application Process - All forms and letters must be completed and submitted to Stephanie Santos, FL 200B no later than February 20th.

- 1. Submit completed application form.
- 2. Include a Letter of Intent detailing your background, why you study Portuguese, your future plans for the use of Portuguese, and why you seek this scholarship.
- 3. Provide transcripts of all university level work. Only applicants with a minimum 3.0 GPA will be considered.
- 4. Provide two Letters of Recommendation authored by your current of previous professors, one of whom should preferably be a professor of Portuguese. Letters of Recommendation can also be sent by the authors to stephanie.santos@ttu.edu.
