Application Process - All forms and letters must be completed and submitted to Stephanie Santos, FL 200B no later than **February 20th.**

1. Submit completed application form.
2. Include a Letter of Intent detailing your background, why you study Portuguese, your future plans for the use of Portuguese, and why you seek this scholarship.
3. Provide transcripts of all university level work. Only applicants with a minimum 3.0 GPA will be considered.
4. Provide two Letters of Recommendation authored by your current or previous professors, one of whom should preferably be a professor of Portuguese. Letters of Recommendation can also be sent by the authors to stephanie.santos@ttu.edu.
