Installing and Configuring Citrix Receiver Client for Access to the Engineering Remote Lab Applications

If you have not done so already, download the latest version of the Citrix Receiver client software from the following link: <u>https://www.citrix.com/go/receiver.html</u>.

Once the Citrix Receiver client executable has finished downloading, double click on it and use the below listed steps to install the software.

1. After you double click the Citrix Receiver client executable, the installation welcome screen will appear. Click Start.
