for First Generation College (FGC) students in our programs

WE FOCUS ON PROGRAM PARTICIPTION **NOT** YOUR GPA

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Be an active FGC student member in our first or second year program
- Attend 4 academic Power Sessions/ SYS workshops
- Attend 4 study sessions
- Attend 4 social engagement events
- Serve the community for a total of 4 hours
- Meet with a professional staff member at least once a semester
- Meet with one of your student mentors once a semester, at a specified day & time

HOW DO I QUALIFY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

To qualify for the scholarship, you must be a first or second-year FGC student in our program who fulfills the minimum program requirements listed above.

HOW CAN I WIN THE SCHOLARSHIP?

To win a scholarship you must fulfill the minimum requirements, as well as earn extra points by attending program-sponsored events, such as additional:

- Academic Power Sessions
- Study sessions
- Social engagement events
- Conversation with the Next Generation events
- Community service opportunities



WHAT IF I MISS ONE OR MORE OF THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS?

Towards the end of the Fall semester, we hold a canned food drive for the South Plains Food Bank.

For every 10 cans you bring, you will receive "attendance" credit for one event. You can do this up to 3 events.

If you already met your minimum requirements, you cannot get extra points, nor receive credit for a missed event.
