

# EMBEDDING A YOUTUBE VIDEO

on a Module Page

## OVERVIEW

Sometimes you may want to share a YouTube video with your students. Instead of providing a long URL, here are the steps to embed an original YouTube video into a module page.

\* Similar steps can be used for embedding videos from files and some other common online videos.




## STEPS

**Step 1** Set “Edit Mode” to **ON**.

**Step 2** Click “Modules” on the left panel. Choose the module (e.g., Module 1) you want to embed a video on.

**Step 3** Click the chevron shaped icon  next to the *Module 1* and select “Edit.”


**Step 4** Place the cursor where you want to insert the video and click the “Insert/Edit Embedded Media” icon.





- Step 5** - Paste the URL of the YouTube video in the “File/URL” field.
- Choose “Iframe” under “Type.”
  - Enter the video size (e.g., 425\*350 default) under “Dimensions.”
  - Click “Insert.”



- Step 6** Click “Submit.”
