These references include, but are not limited to, the following: past professors (not current EPCE professors), supervisors, boss, director, and volunteer supervisor employed by the organization. References that are not acceptable include, but are not limited to, spiritual leaders, people under your supervision, past students, neighbors, anyone related to you, and personal friends.

GRE Scores – Your GRE scores must be from within the last five years. Please request that ETS send an official score report to Texas Tech University (institution code 6827).
