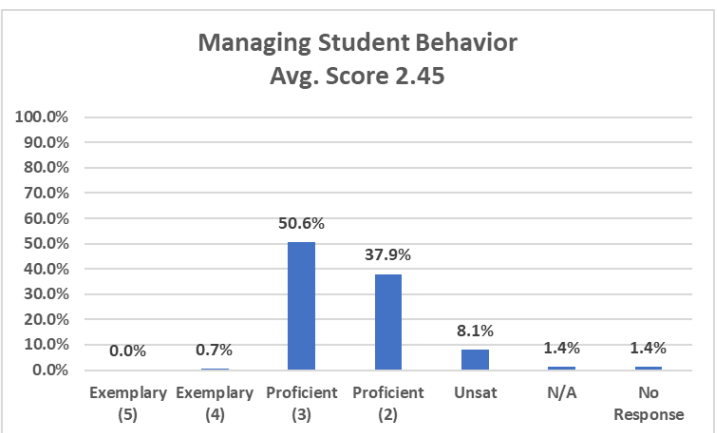
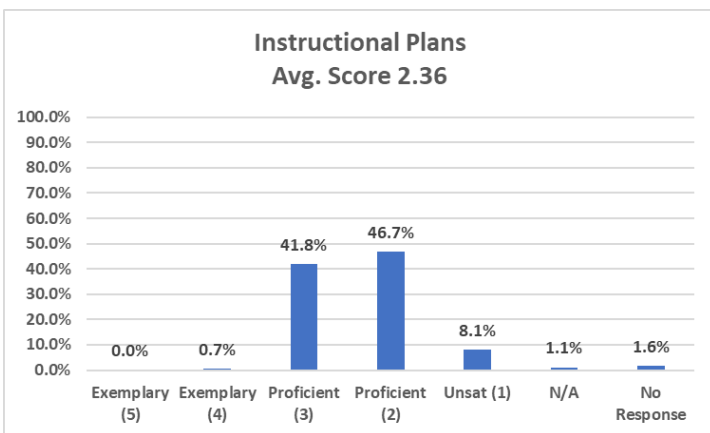
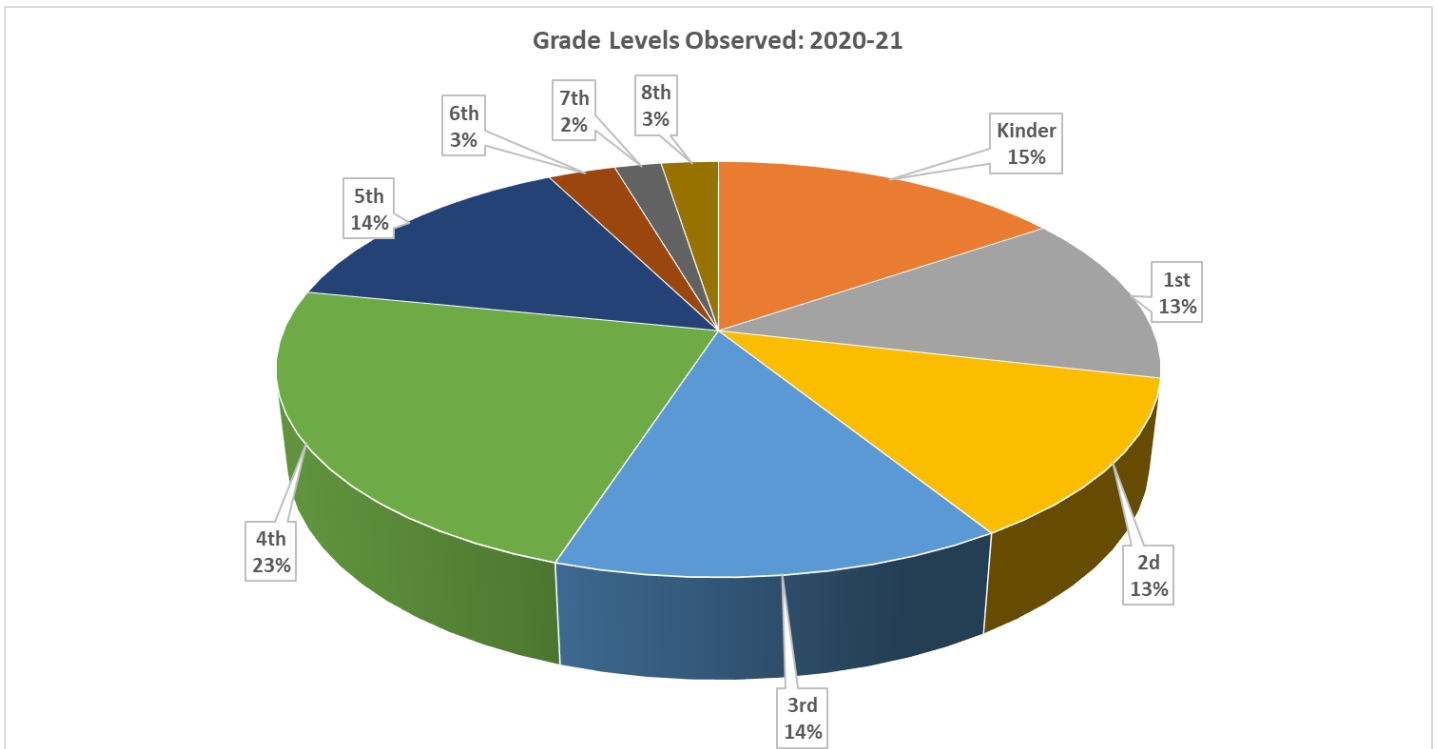

The TAP Teaching Standards Rubric is divided into four domains: Instruction, Designing & Planning, Learning Environment, & Professionalism.

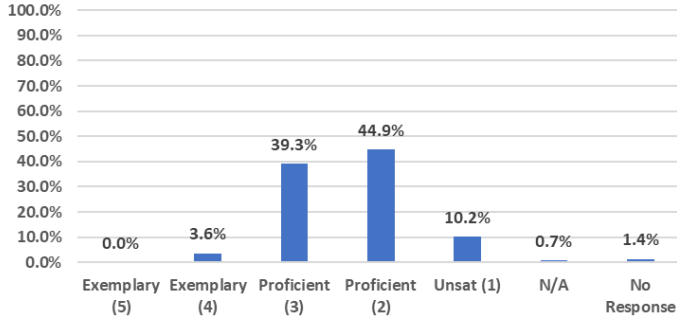
Within each domain, performance indicators are listed with bulleted descriptors and a rubric specifying three performance levels for measuring actual teacher performance.

Teachers are rated on the following scale:

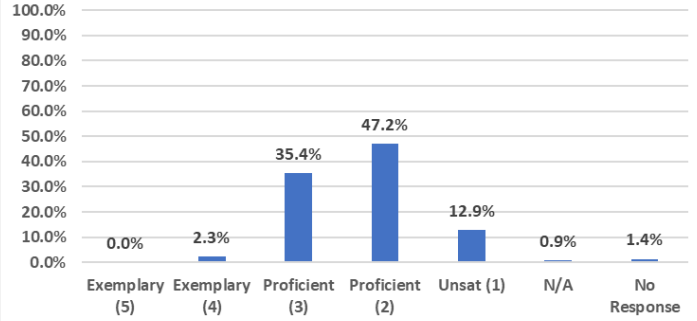
1 (Unsatisfactory), 2 (Proficient), 3 (Proficient), 4 (Exemplary), 5 (Exemplary)



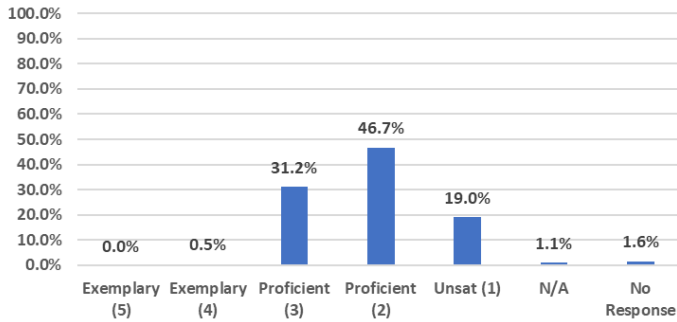

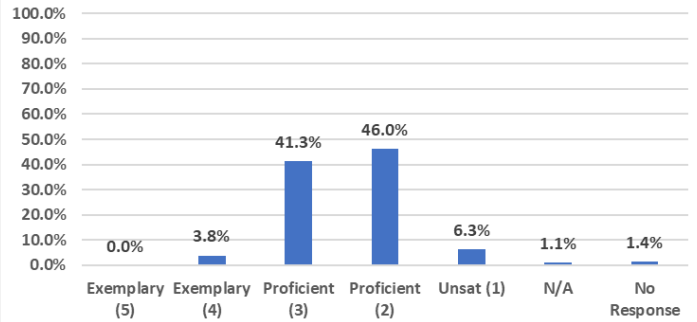

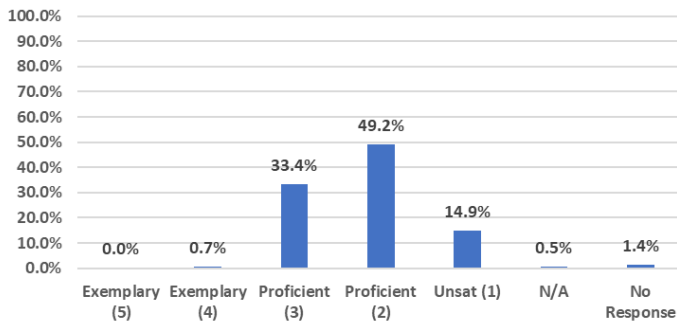

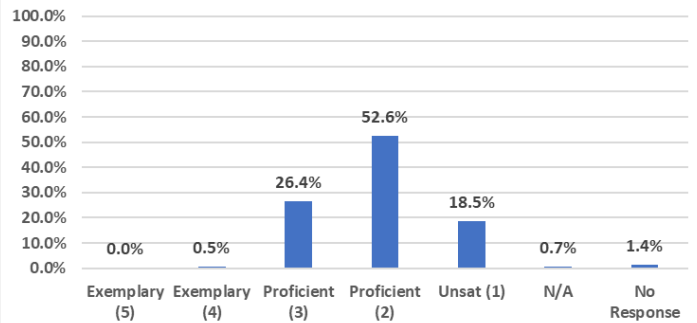

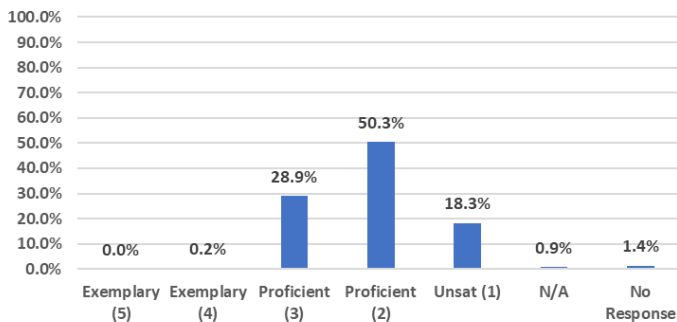

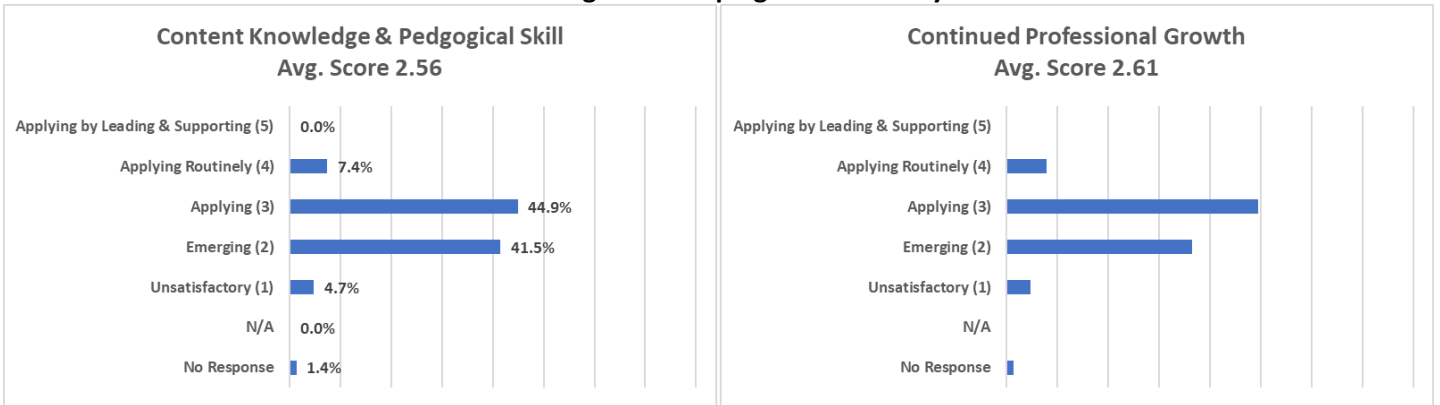
