

Managing Universal Waste

State and Federal regulations require Texas Tech to manage universal waste generation in an environmentally-conscious and responsible manner. Follow these tips for effective management!

Segregation • Properly segregate different lamp types, light ballasts (PCB and non-PCB) and emergency ballasts (battery pack from other components).









2 Quantity Management & Packaging • Pack waste appropriately. Do not overfill collection containers. Different waste types have different container fill limits.








Wound Motors



Some wastes just need a label affixed directly (e.g., pesticide) to the container or to be placed in any sturdy box (e.g., batteries).

3 Label Container with Universal Waste Label • Complete all fields on label.





PRO TIP: Use a clipboard to track number of items in container

4 Submit Online Pick Up Request • All universal waste pick up requests must be submitted online at www.ehs.ttu.edu.







Pick up can take up to **1 month** due to the high volume of waste requests across campus.
