If you are eligible for Texas residency status under House Bill 1403 or Senate Bill 1528, use this checklist to aid you in gathering all the necessary requirements for submission of the TASFA.

Submit the TASFA and supporting documentation by **January 15** each year if you are applying for any of the following types of financial assistance:

- Undergraduate Students: TTU Scholarships, TEXAS Grant, College Access Loan (CAL), Private Education Loan (with credit-worthy, U.S. resident co-signer)
- Graduate Students: College Access Loan (CAL), Private Education Loan (with credit-worthy, U.S. resident co-signer)

Requirements:

Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA)

Signed and completed fully (no blanks).

SB 1528 Residency Affidavit (first-time applicants only)

Selective Service Registration (male students only)

All male U.S. citizens and male immigrants, who are 18 through 25, are required by law to register with Selective Service.

Income Documentation

2018 Tax Return (signed) or 2018 Tax Return Transcript for student and parent(s). Form W-2 and/or signed statement of earnings may be provided in lieu of Tax Return or Transcript if taxes were not filed.
