International applicants may request an exemption from the English proficiency requirement if:

- They are citizens from countries exempted by the Texas Tech University Board of Regents from the English proficiency requirement. Proof of citizenship must be submitted to receive the exemption.
- They have completed or will complete a university-level degree (associate's, bachelor's, master's, etc.) or who have completed at least four consecutive semesters of non-developmental, non-intensive English coursework at a regionally accredited college or university in the United States of America or at a ministry-recognized college/university in a country exempted by the Texas Tech University Board of Regents from the English proficiency requirements. Transcripts from the institution(s) attended must be submitted to receive the exemption.
- They are applying for conditional admission for English proficiency through the university's English language instruction partner, ELS. Students admitted with this exemption must provide proof of completion of ELS' English for Academic Purposes prior to being allowed to register for their degree coursework.
