Doctorate in Nutrition or related field and Registered Dietitian credential. Direct community nutrition experience, college teaching experience, and a demonstrated ability to establish a focused research program, secure external funding, and publish in peer-reviewed journals are required. Current external funding is desired.

**Responsibilities:**

Teach undergraduate and graduate courses related to community nutrition including nutrition and wellness, nutrition education, cultural foods, international nutrition, obesity prevention and intervention. Service on departmental, college, and university committees is also expected. Establish an independent research program in community nutrition related to cancer, diabetes, or other chronic disease prevention capable of attracting external funding and leading to publications in refereed journals. Excellent opportunities are available to partner with multidisciplinary teams within the Department of Nutrition, Hospitality and Retailing, College of Human Sciences, Agriculture and Health related departments on campus, Texas Tech Health Sciences Center, and Texas AgriLife Extension. Advise undergraduate and graduate students, supervise graduate student research, and serve on committees.
