Showcase Results

Showcase learning, share results, and celebrate accomplishments.

During the final phase of the service-learning process, you bring everything together, share what you've learned, highlight how you have helped the community, recognize those who have assisted you along the way, and celebrate how people working together can make communities better!

After you have thought about the impact of your project, share the reflections with others:

- Create a Power Point presentation
- Write an essay, an article for the school newspaper, or write a letter to the editor of the local newspaper
- Produce a short video highlighting what you've learned
- Construct a display board (like a science fair display but all about your project!)
- Compose a song
- Create a piece of artwork

Come up with your own creative way to showcase your efforts! Your showcase can include:

- A ribbon cutting
- A service fair
- An appreciation assembly
- A presentation to the School Board, City Council, or other group

Remember to include others at your event:

- Parents
- Community partners
- Students and teachers from other classes
- Local news media
- District level staff
- Chamber of Commerce or business leaders

As a group, brainstorm potential ways to showcase the results of the project.

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
