

STUDY TOUR IN APPAREL DESIGN 2012

APPAREL DESIGN & MANUFACTURING ADM3325/SPRING 2012

Class: Elective course, 3 hours credit, meets weekly. Seminar class researches the world of fashion design through the study of a specific city and includes a trip to New York, New York (6 days) over Spring Break

Cost: Tuition for a 3 hour class,
plus a Special Field Trip Fee: \$975.00

Includes: Lodging in New York City (5 nights), many special tours, and two celebration dinners in New York City.

Airfare: **Students are to purchase their plane tickets**
Note: Cost of airfare is not included in the trip fee for the class. Copy of ticket to be presented 2nd week of class.

Trip: Five nights lodging near Times Square in New York City.

A day at the New York museums and walking tours of historic New York City and fashion center landmarks.

A day sourcing and purchasing fabric and trims in the NYC garment center and local designer street markets.

Visits to New York fashion showrooms , apparel manufacturers and contractors.

Free time for the "New York Experience" and much more.

Course: Participants will study aspects of fashion design in a specific city. The seminar will challenge the student to consider the role a city has in shaping the design and consumer market of the apparel design & manufacturing industry. Seminar requirements will include readings, presentations, and analysis of fashion design elements.
