

COLLEGE OF HUMAN SCIENCES RESEARCH COMMITTEE

CHARGE

The Research Committee promotes, encourages, and supports research activities in the College of Human Sciences (COHS).

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Identify needs of COHS faculty and staff and assist with proposal development.
- 2. As needed, review internal seed grant proposals and make recommendations to the Associate Dean for Research about distribution of research related funding.
- 3. Highlight COHS research activities via contributions to the COHS Research website and other outlets.
- 4. Evaluate research-related operating policies on a regular basis.

MEMBERSHIP

- 1. The committee is composed of one faculty member from each academic unit and one member selected from among the college centers and institutes.
- Department chairpersons will appoint the representative from the academic units, and the Associate Dean for Research will appoint an individual to represent COHS Centers and Institutes.
- 3. Appointment terms are annual, and members can be reappointed.

OPERATING PROCEDURES

- 1. The committee will meet periodically as needed to carry out assigned responsibilities.
- 2. The Associate Dean for Research serves as chair of the committee and facilitates its work.
