**THE COLLEGIATE RECOVERY COMMUNITY
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

The Collegiate Recovery Community at Texas Tech University provides a nurturing, affirming environment in which students recovering from addictive disorders can successfully pursue academic, personal, and professional goals for the purpose of enhancing their quality of life and becoming productive members of society. The community is open to all students in recovery who are actively pursuing higher education at Texas Tech University and who are committed to growth in recovery.

The Collegiate Recovery Community (CRC) offers scholarships to members who exhibit continuing commitment to leadership and academics. Typically, scholarships range in amounts from \$500.00 to \$2,000.00 per semester depending on student G.P.A. and other criteria including the leadership they show in the community. However, awards of greater amounts are available for those students who are exemplary leaders in the academic and Collegiate Recovery Communities. In addition to the above mentioned requirements, students wishing to receive a scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Scholarship candidates must have at least one year of complete abstinence from alcohol and other drugs and/or all process addictions.
2. Scholarship candidates must enroll for, and complete, at least 12 hours credit, with a G.P.A. of 3.0 or better.
3. Scholarship applications should include the following items: **BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT** – regarding your personal recovery. **Three (3) LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION** – from individuals who can attest to both your leadership ability and your success in recovery. **A formal COVER LETTER** - including a statement of educational and career goals.
4. Scholarship candidates must complete the Scholarship Application (See Attached) and return it by the May 1st deadline.
