International Student Post-Arrival Checklist

The listed items can be completed AFTER your arrival to Texas Tech.

Required

- [Check-In](#) with your Immigration Counselor
 - Schedule an appointment 1-3 days after arrival
 - Bring I-20, passport, and I-94
- Complete [TSI Test](#) if applicable
 - Take the [TSI pre-test online](#) before you take the in-person exam
 - Test is required for course registration
- Attend [Red Raider Orientation \(RRO\)](#)
 - Attendance is required for course registration
- Attend mandatory [International Student Orientation](#)
- Obtain Insurance Card (will be mailed to the address listed on eRaider)
 - Pick up your card at Student Health Services if you do not have a local address on file
 - Insurance fee will appear on your bill 24-48 hours after you register for courses
- Make tuition, fees, and on-campus housing payments to [Student Business Services](#)
 - Bill is available after you register for classes at eBill on Raiderlink
 - There are a variety of payment plans
- Get your [Texas Tech Student ID Card](#)
- Submit Official Transcripts to [International Admissions](#)
