	O Take the TSI pre-test online before you take the in-person exam
	<ul> <li>Test is required for course registration</li> </ul>
	Attend Red Raider Orientation (RRO)
_	Attendance is required for course registration
	Attend mandatory International Student Orientation
	Obtain Insurance Card (will be mailed to the address listed on eRaider)
	<ul> <li>Pick up your card at Student Health Services if you do not have a local address on file</li> </ul>
	o Insurance fee will appear on your bill 24-48 hours after you register for courses
	Make tuition, fees, and on-campus housing payments to <b>Student Business Services</b>
	o Bill is available after you register for classes at eBill on Raiderlink
