Board of Regents July 7, 2016

Thursday, July 7, 2016.—The members of the Board of Regents of the Texas Tech University System convened in a special-called meeting by teleconference at 9:30 am on Thursday, July 7, 2016, in the Board Room, Room 201, Second Floor, Administration Building, Akron and Broadway Avenues, Lubbock, Texas, with the following in attendance:
