The department offers state-of-the-art research equipment and laboratories in its own building, which also includes six classrooms, a student computer lab, and faculty offices. The department also has approximately 1,300 undergraduate and 40 graduate students earning a B.S. in Kinesiology or M.S. in Kinesiology.
