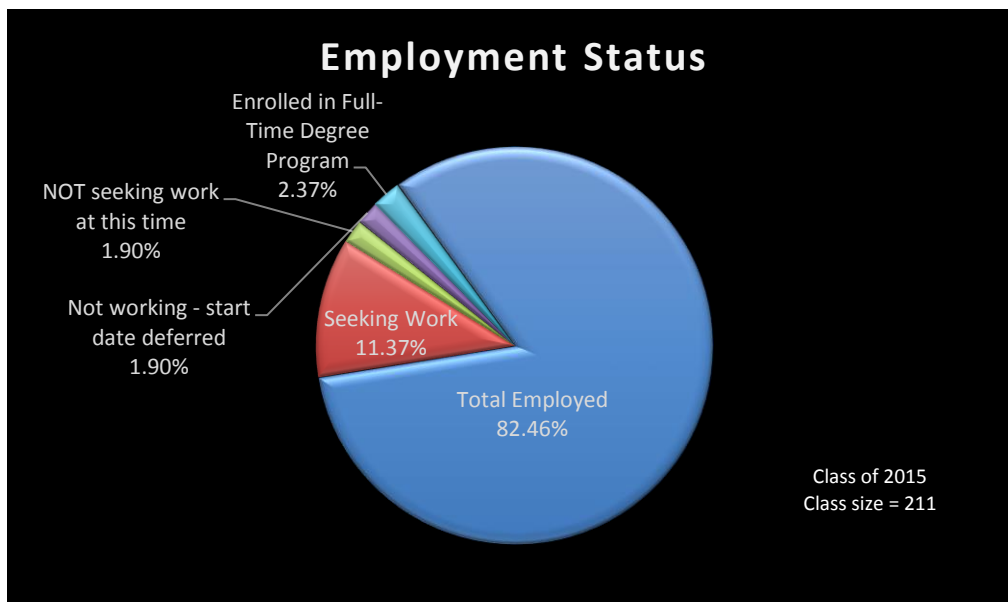

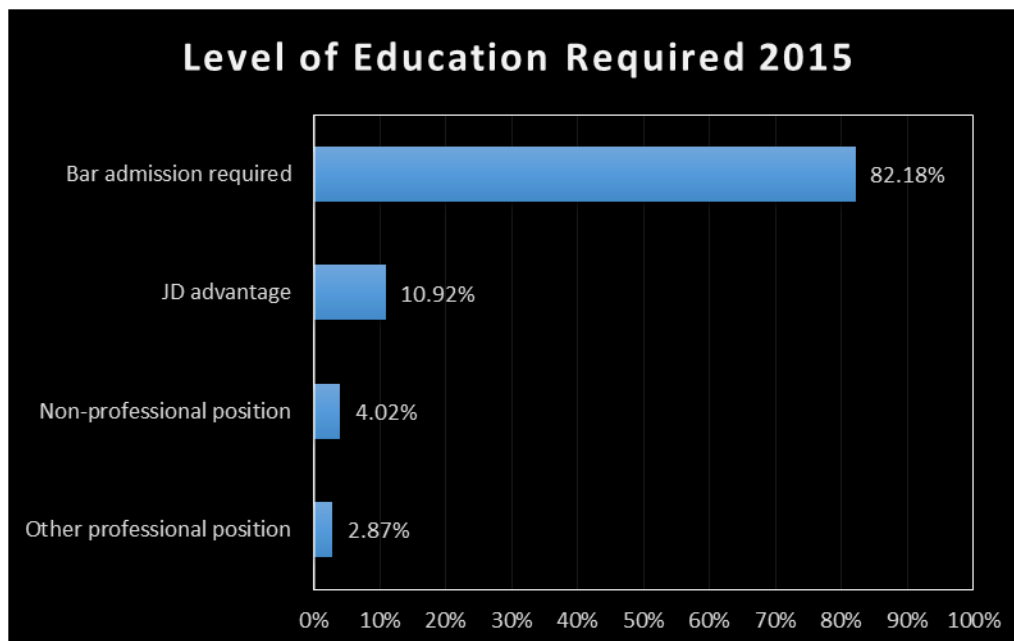

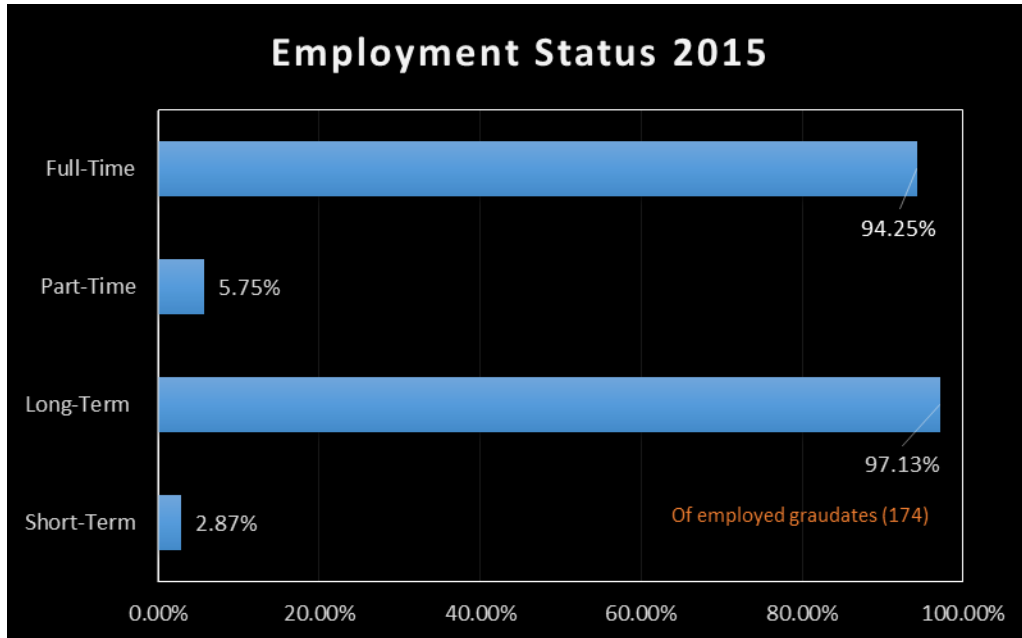
Texas Tech Law Class of 2015 Employment Status ten months after graduation (as of March 15, 2016)



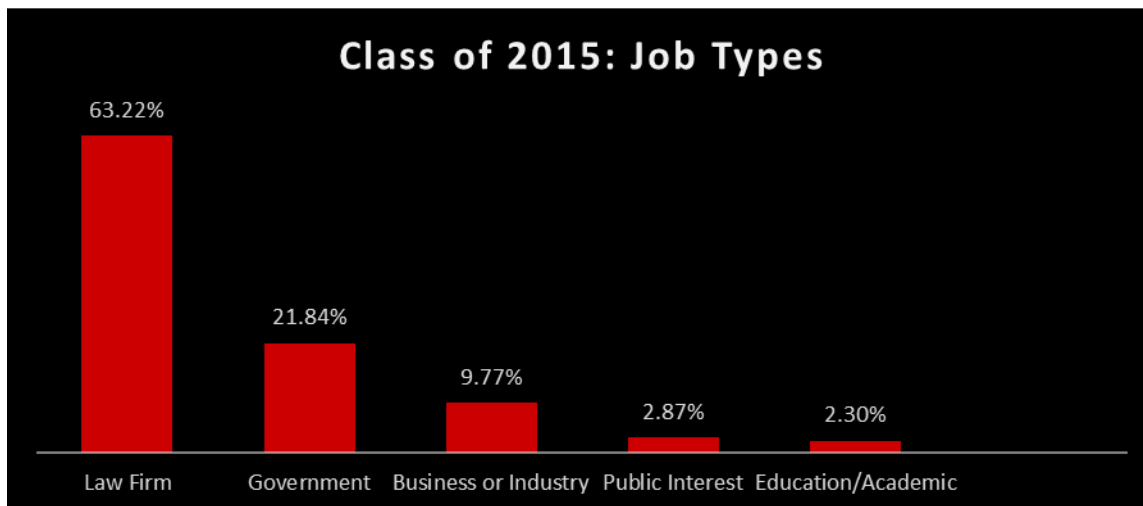
Texas Tech Law Class of 2015 Employment by Education Required

Texas Tech Law Class of 2015 Job Types



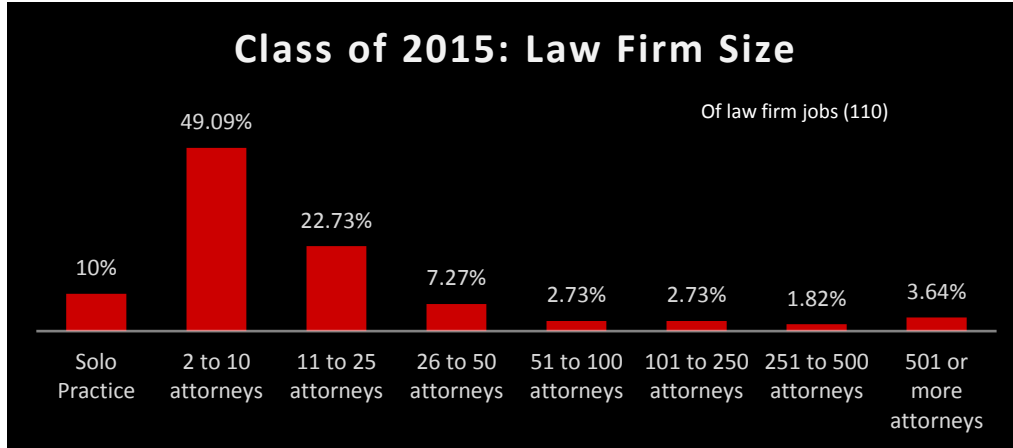

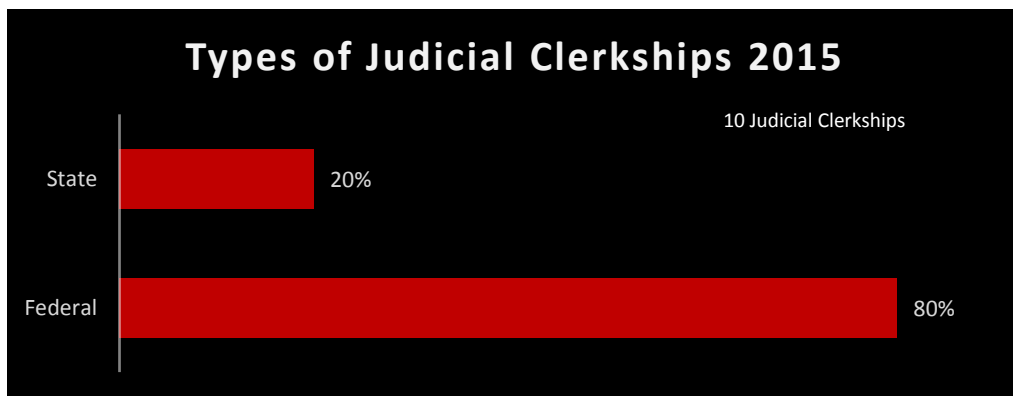

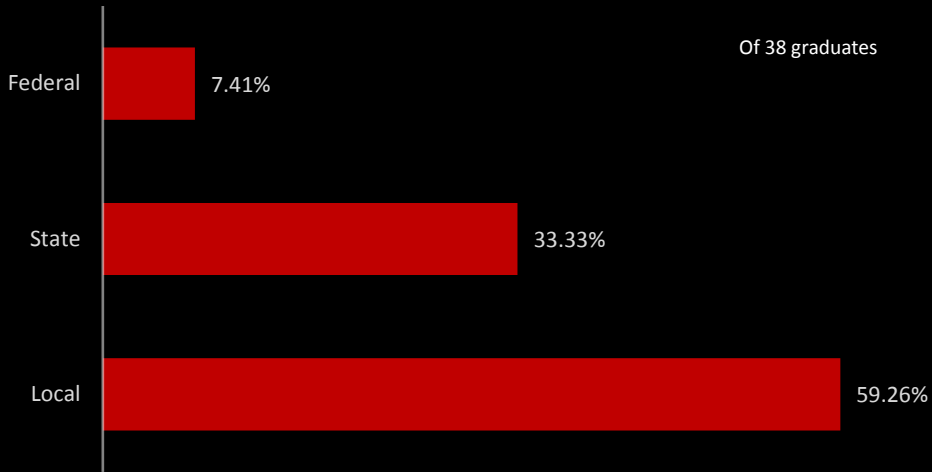

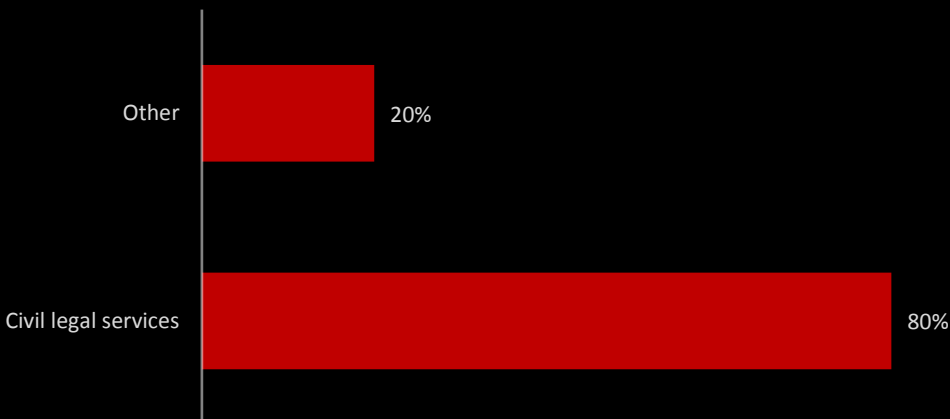

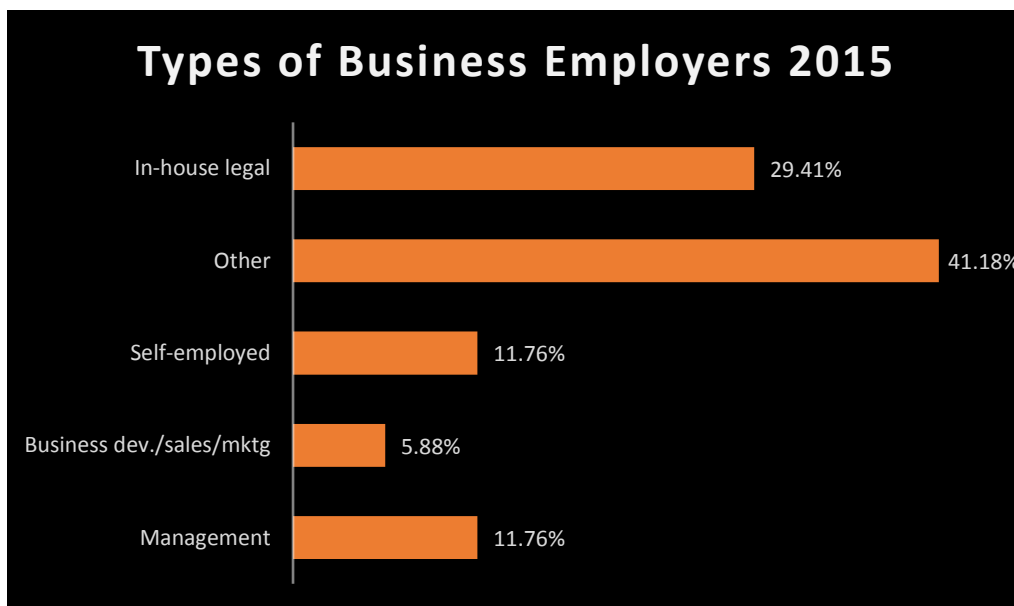
