AUDITIONS

All students will audition on Sunday, July 7th for ensemble placement. Audition materials will be available at TTUBOC.COM in early April.

HOUSING

Housing for ON-CAMPUS students will be in TTU residence halls. Rooms are air conditioned and include linens.

DINING

Meals are provided to on-campus students through the residence hall dining services and include several choices as well as vegetarian options.

COMMUTERS
