WHAT IS A RAIDER ROOM?

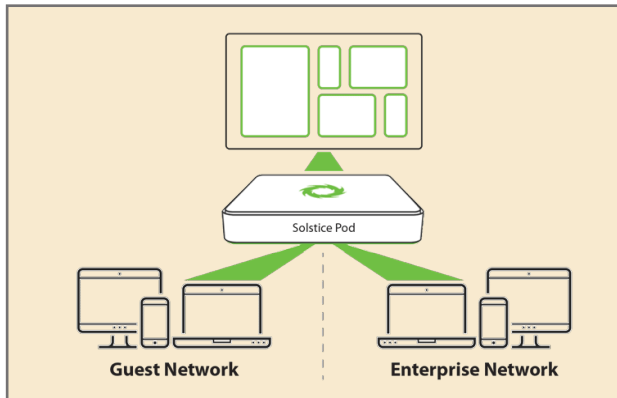
Raider Rooms are designed to serve the entire TTU campus community by providing a wide range of equipment, technology and resources. These classrooms are centrally scheduled, and are maintained by Operations Division Planning & Administration. This project would not be possible without vital partnerships with IT Help Central Classroom Technology Services.

How do I schedule a Raider Room for my class?

Please contact your department's collaborative academic scheduler or scheduling point of contact and they can request the space for your section. In order for sections to be scheduled in Raider Rooms, they must meet the following criteria:

- Space Usage Efficiency (SUE): 65% Fill
- Credit bearing sections are scheduled before other activities.
- Section must meet on standard time patterns (refer to OP 61.23 for additional information)

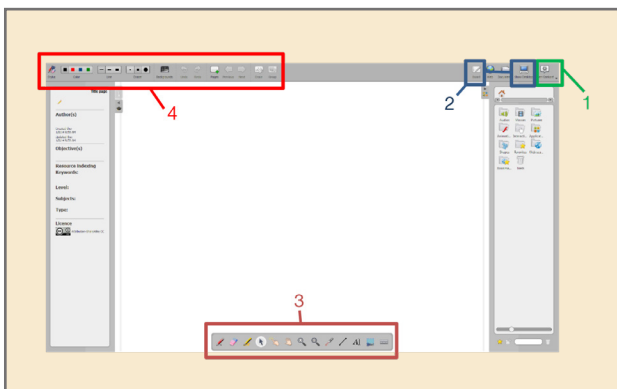
SOLSTICE POD

The Solstice Pod is a wireless presentation system. With the help of this technology, instructors will be able to share and control presentations collaboratively and wirelessly. Multiple users from multiple devices (Android and iOS) are able to instantly connect to their smart devices. Through the Pod, users can use this platform to wirelessly stream media content. Those in charge of operating the device can do so via their web browser.



DOCUMENT CAMERA

The Document Camera allows students to have a more interactive classroom with their instructor. Regardless of the subject that is being taught the document camera will help students to view three dimensional shapes, lecture notes, and lab activities from the instructor.



OPEN-SANKORÉ

Open-Sankoré is a free and open-source interactive whiteboard software compatible with any projector and pointing device. This software allows instructors to save and publish whiteboard content, and add additional whiteboard space in rooms with challenging sight lines. The annotation software is installed on all Raider Room computers.
