

PFP Graduate Application Process

Admission to Graduate School at Texas Tech University is a two-stage process. Applicants are first admitted by the Graduate School of the University and then by the specific department in which they wish to study. Therefore, materials must be sent both to the department and to the Graduate School.

1. Graduate School Application

- Graduate School Application must be submitted on-line at www.depts.ttu.edu/gradschool.
Click on Prospective Students. Then click on the TTU on-line application and follow the directions. If you have any questions please call 806-742-2787
- There is a \$50.00 non-refundable application fee
- All transcripts from each university you list on your grad school application.

2. Departmental Application

Although criteria vary, most include: scholarship, excellence, achievement in academic and non-academic areas, leadership, character, seriousness of purpose, and/or need. Scholarships are awarded only to those who have officially applied to Texas Tech University. **All graduate students are required to apply for a scholarship in the Graduate School. When you apply for a scholarship in the Graduate School you will check a box indicating that you would like to be considered for a College of Human Sciences scholarship. YOU WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR A COLLEGE OF HUMAN SCIENCES SCHOLARSHIP IF YOU DO NOT APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP IN THE GRADUATE SCHOOL.** In addition to your application, you must have an official transcript on file at TTU.
