

## Students accepted to the Texas Tech graduate programs in Political Science can expect:

## Requisites to be considered for the program include:

- Students' academic transcripts including any graduate work
- Graduate Record Examination scores (GRE),
- Letters of recommendation 3 for Political
  Science 2 for Public Administration
- Statement of purpose
- International students are required to provide their TOEFL scores.
- Curriculum Vitae

Applications will be considered at any time throughout the year. However, to be fully considered for all available financial assistance, completed applications should be submitted by **January 15** of the year the student expects to begin graduate study.
