Pre-Nursing Mentoring Program Description

The pre-nursing mentorship program is a unique experience where a TTU undergraduate student pursuing admission to nursing school will be paired with a TTUHSC nursing student who will act as a mentor. This up-close look at life in nursing school will allow the pre-nursing student to have confidence in their commitment and provide valuable material for the critically important essay portion of the nursing school application.

The mentor/mentee experience will include:

- Each pre-nursing mentee will be paired up with a nursing student mentor.
- Each mentee will attend at least two classes involving different courses with their mentor on days that work best for the mentee/mentor pair. The mentors are encouraged to take their mentee to more classes if possible.
- ➤ The mentors will provide advice about the nursing school experience and answer questions the mentee may have.
