Pre-Speech, Language, and Hearing Mentoring Program Description

The pre-speech, language, and hearing mentorship program is a unique experience where a TTU undergraduate student pursuing admission to speech, language, and hearing school will be paired with a TTUHSC speech, language, and hearing student who will act as a mentor. This up-close look at life in speech, language, and hearing school will allow the pre-speech, language, and hearing student to have confidence in their commitment and provide valuable material for the critically important essay portion of the speech, language, and hearing school application.

The mentor/mentee experience will include:

- Each pre-speech, language, and hearing mentee will be paired up with a speech, language, and hearing student mentor.
- Each mentee will attend at least two classes involving different courses with their mentor on days that work best for the mentee/mentor pair. The mentors are encouraged to take their mentee to more classes if possible.
- The mentors will provide advice about the speech, language, and hearing school experience and answer questions the mentee may have.

IS 3110 *Seminar in Health Professions* is a pre- or co-requisite for participation in the mentoring program.
