II. New Business

1. **Augment the GEC Criteria** for Including Courses in the Core with specific examples. A sample set of SLO/Assessment methods for MGT3373 and AGED4302 were discussed. The first used a tabular format, the latter a numbered-list format. After all the examples have been submitted (Monday, May 21), the GEC will select (via email discussion) two or three representative formats, enough to give faculty the flexibility to retain control of their syllabi. However, due to the large number of courses that will have to be reviewed in 2008-09, it was moved and approved that **faculty submitting syllabi for Core approval will be required to use one of the listed formats.**
2. **Document Upload Feature of the GEC Website:** this item is nearly ready for production, but must still undergo usability evaluation and thorough testing. Those wishing to view progress to date may go to <https://appdev.itts.ttu.edu/staging/GEC/Faculty/>. It is possible to upload a document for Fall 2008, but any documents uploaded will be deleted in the testing process. The Spring 2009 course information will be under Banner instead of TechSIS, and there are issues remaining to be resolved before the document upload feature is ready for use with Banner.
3. **Foreign Language blanket statement.** CMLL responded to a request for a list of courses to replace the blanket statement appearing on page 43 of the 2007-08 catalog allowing a FL course to satisfy the Humanities requirement under certain restrictions. **The FL blanket statement and its replacement were approved** and are listed in the Summary of Individual Course Actions document in the appendix to these minutes.
4. **Recommendation regarding a permanent role for the Core Competency committees.** The GEC has been requested to submit a recommendation for making these committees a permanent part of the TTU academic administration. That recommendation is item ii. in the Appendix.

Charge for the Core Curriculum Task Forces

Introduction

Core Curriculum Task Forces were created during spring semester 2008 on an ad hoc basis for the purpose of developing college-level and course-level learning outcomes and assessments for the core curriculum. Task forces were appointed for each of the six Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) mandated core curriculum components plus two additional requirements which are local TTU core components and a foreign language task force, appointed because of the foreign language requirement in the College of Arts and Sciences. Toward the end of the spring semester 2008, after the task forces had completed their primary mission, it was decided to institutionalize them as subcommittees of the General Education Committee (GEC). The charge below is part of this institutionalization process.

The existing core curriculum task forces will be disbanded as of January 1, 2009 and replaced by new members appointed by the General Education Committee as per the procedure set forth in this charge. Because foreign language is not part of the core curriculum for the university, that task force will be eliminated. Members of the existing competency teams will be encouraged to serve in the same capacity under the new charge as their expertise is essential for a smooth transition to a permanent role in monitoring the Core Curriculum.

Charge

There will be eight core curriculum task forces, each of which is responsible for monitoring the assessment process for its designated core curriculum area. These areas are:

Core Area A: Communications

Core Area B: Mathematics and Logic

Core Area C: Natural Sciences

Core Area D: Technology and Applied Science

Core Area E: Humanities

Core Area F: Visual and Performing Arts

Core Area G: Social and Behavioral Sciences

Multicultural

Core Curriculum task forces will make recommendations to the General Education Committee based on their evaluation of:

- (1) college-level student outcomes,
- (2) course-level outcomes,
- (3) assessment strategies for the college and course level outcomes,
- (4) review of the results of college-level and course-level assessments.

The GEC considers task force recommendations and acts on them as it deems to be appropriate based on a simple majority vote.

Composition of the Task Forces:

Each task force will have five members and will be chaired by a General Education Committee member from a discipline related as closely as possible to the core area in question. Each committee will thus be composed of six individuals. Members of the task forces will be appointed by the chair of the GEC in collaboration with the committee chair. Terms are for three years. When a Task Force chair ends his/her term on the General Education Committee he or she will be replaced by an appropriate GEC member.

Members of the core area task forces should represent academic units which have a significant level of participation in that area. Some disciplines have a large number of courses in a specific Core Area and should be represented by at least one member on the associated task force. Otherwise, membership is open to faculty from any department which offers Core courses in the specific area.

The departments which must be represented are:

Core Area A: Communication

English, Communication Studies

Core Area B: Mathematics

Mathematics, Philosophy

Core Area C: Natural Sciences

Biology, Chemistry, Physics

Core Area D: (no single department has an overwhelming representation in the Core)

Core Area E: Humanities

English, History, Philosophy

Core Area F: Visual and Performing Arts

Art, Music, Theatre and Dance

Core Area G: (no single department has an overwhelming representation in the Core)

Multicultural: (no single department has an overwhelming representation in the Core)
