CHARACTERISTICS OF ENGAGED SCHOLARSHIP

- **Engaged scholarship** involves scholarly activities designed to address a community need or societal issue through:
 - Research
 - Creative Activity
 - Teaching
 - Service

- Faculty collaborate with community partners in mutually beneficial ways to share knowledge and expertise.
- There is a clear link between the activity and the academic mission.
- Faculty involve the affected community in the process of problem-solving.
- Faculty and community partners develop activity objectives and agree on desired outcomes.
- Faculty and community partners co-create new knowledge for both the discipline and communities.

DEFINITIONS

OUTREACH

refers to the one-way delivery of programs, services, activities, or expertise to those outside of the university. It involves Texas Tech providing education, consultation, and other services to benefit the community.

ENGAGEMENT

involves Texas Tech in mutually beneficial relationships with the community to address societal needs and challenges. It leverages Texas Tech's academic expertise and resources with the knowledge and experiences of community partners.

ENGAGED SCHOLARSHIP

is a form of scholarship that involves a two-way, reciprocal partnership between Texas Tech and the community for the purpose of addressing a community need or larger societal challenge. It leverages disciplinary knowledge and scholarly practice with the knowledge and experiences of the community in mutually beneficial ways, using documented results to advance scholarship as well as community/societal interests.
