

## **Faculty, Advising, and Administrative offices have been moved**

Students, colleagues, and friends:

A few weeks ago, there was a major water leak in the Department of Psychological Sciences building. A majority of the building was damaged, including classrooms, faculty and advising offices, laboratories, etc. Fixing the damage will require major renovations. Thus, the Department of Psychological Sciences' building will be closed for the foreseeable future. We hope to have the building open again by February 2018.

Until further notice, the Department of Psychological Science's faculty and advising offices will be temporarily housed in Drane Hall. The Psychological Clinic is open, and can be accessed only through the north entrance (closest to the library) to the building. Unfortunately, department laboratories will be shuttered until the building reopens.

Please note that any Spring 2018 classes that were scheduled to be taught in the Department of Psychological Sciences' building will be moved to different classrooms than originally planned. Accordingly, students should be on the lookout for classroom re-assignments as the semester approaches. On a related note, students who are enrolled in PSY 4000 during Spring 2018 should contact your laboratory directors for guidance regarding how to fulfill your duties as the semester approaches.

We are working very hard to minimize the impact of this situation, and appreciate your understanding as we do our best to deal with this difficult circumstance. As unknowns become knowns, we will share more information with you.
