

Grant Thornton Accounting Scholarship

For Texas Tech Accounting Students

Qualification Requirements:

1. Applicants must have completed a minimum of 60 semester hours of undergraduate coursework
2. Applicants must be junior accounting majors currently seeking internship opportunities
3. Applicants must have completed Intermediate Accounting I by December 2013
4. Applicants must plan on pursuing CPA eligibility (150hr requirement) upon graduation
5. Applicants must have achieved a 3.2 or greater overall and major Grade Point Average
6. Applicants must be U.S. citizens or U.S. permanent residents
7. Applicants must prepare a typed essay, not to exceed 500 words. ***Personal Essay Topic*** Grant Thornton's Global Values are Collaboration, Leadership, Excellence, Agility, Respect and Responsibility. Your essay should describe how you have demonstrated one or all of these values in your academic career and/or through your work experience and why you believe these values are important. In addition, briefly outline your career goals in the area of accounting.

How do I apply for the scholarship?

Submit a **copy** of your accounting departmental scholarship application, your resume and your essay to julie.hatfield@us.gt.com. All required scholarship information must be received by close of business on **Friday, February 7th**.

How are applicants selected to receive the scholarship?

All applications will be reviewed by Grant Thornton's scholarship review committee. Based on initial applications, finalists will be interviewed in person by a Grant Thornton partner. All interviewees will be required to provide an official university transcript.

How will I be notified if I am selected as a scholarship recipient?

All selected scholarship recipients will be notified by telephone and/or formal letter from the Grant Thornton scholarship review committee.
