Admission to the Rawls College of Business as an internal transfer (TTU student) requires a minimum 2.75 TTU GPA on a minimum of 15 TTU credit hours. Admission to the Rawls College of Business as an external transfer (NON-TTU student) is a minimum of 2.75 GPA on a minimum of 15 credit hours. Students will be classified as COBA until completion of the Lower Division Business Core with grades of C or higher, and a cumulative 2.75 TTU GPA. Students below a 2.75 will not be permitted to take Business courses. Admission to COBA does not guarantee admission to any Business major, as each program has specified program requirements.
