Students are classified as COBA (College of Business Administration) majors until the Lower Division Business Core has been completed with grades of C or higher and a 3.0 or higher Tech GPA has been attained.

LOWER DIVISION BUSINESS CORE

31 HOURS – GRADES OF C OR HIGHER ARE REQUIRED

- BA 1101** **Fundamentals of Business Professionalism.** Prerequisite: 2.75 GPA
- ENGL 1301** **Essentials of College Rhetoric.** Prerequisite: Minimum SATV/370 or ACTV/16 or ENGL 0301 ENGL 0301 will not be used in the degree program
- ENGL 1302** **Advanced College Rhetoric.** Prerequisite: ENGL 1301
- MATH 1330*** **Introductory Mathematical Analysis.** Prerequisite: Satisfactory score on the Mathematics Placement Exam (MPE) or a grade of A or B in MATH 0302. Students who are required to take MATH 0301 must earn a grade of A or B before taking MATH 0302
- MATH 1331*** **Introductory Mathematical Analysis.** Prerequisite: Minimum grade of C in MATH 1330
- ACCT 2300** **Financial Accounting.** Prerequisite: Sophomore standing and completion of any college-level Math and a 2.75 GPA
- ACCT 2301** **Managerial Accounting.** Prerequisite: ACCT 2300 and a 2.75 GPA required
- ISQS 2340** **Introduction to Computer Systems in Business.** Prerequisite: Minimum grade of C in any college-level Math. 2.75 GPA required
- MATH 2345*** **Introduction to Statistics With Applications to Business.** Prerequisite: Code 4 or higher on MPE or a score of at least 610 on the SATM or a score of at least 26 on the ACTM, or minimum grade of C in Math 1330 or 1430
- ECO 2301** **Principles of Economics I. (Microeconomics)**
- ECO 2302** **Principles of Economics II. (Macroeconomics)**

*A Math course must be taken each enrollment until the Math requirement is finished

OTHER FRESHMAN AND SOPHOMORE REQUIRED COURSES

26 HOURS – GRADES OF D OR HIGHER ARE REQUIRED

- HIST 2300** **History of the United States to 1877.** Any other U.S. History course chosen from Core Curriculum Category G may be substituted for HIST 2300
 - HIST 2301** **History of the United States since 1877.** Any other U.S. History course chose from core curriculum Category G may be substituted for HIST 2301
 - POLS 1301** **American Government, Organization.**
 - POLS 2302** **American Public Policy.** Completion of POLS 1301 is strongly recommended
- HUMANITIES COURSE**
 Three semester hours chosen from the Core Curriculum, Category E
- VISUAL and PERFORMING ARTS**
 Three semester hours chosen from Core Curriculum, Category F
- LAB SCIENCE**
 Two courses (8 hours) chosen from Core Curriculum, Category C. The science lecture and the corresponding lab should be taken at the same time The two science courses can be in different fields, such as Biology and Geology

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

11 HOURS – GRADES OF C OR HIGHER ARE REQUIRED

Three semesters in a single language or completion of a proficiency test in that language for 11 hours credit or more, if available.

FIN 3320	Financial Management. Prerequisite: ACCT 2300, 2301, ECO 2301, ECO 2302, MATH 2345 and minimum 2.75 Tech GPA
ISQS 3344	Introduction to Production and Operations Management. Prerequisite: ISQS 2340, MATH 2345 and minimum 2.75 Tech GPA
MKT 3350	Introduction to Marketing. Prerequisite: ECO 2301 and minimum 2.75 Tech GPA
MGT 3370	Organization and Management. Prerequisite: Minimum 2.75 Tech GPA
MGT 3373	Managerial Communication. Prerequisite: ISQS 2340 and minimum grade of C in ENGL 1301 and 1302 and minimum 2.75 Tech GPA

FIN 4328	International Finance. Prerequisite: FIN 3323

MKT 4358	International Marketing. Prerequisite: MKT 3350 with a minimum grade of C
