Students will be required to have completed all lower division business core courses and have a minimum GPA of 3.25 by the start of the fall semester they take ENCO 3301 and ENCO 3350. Limited space is available in Energy Commerce courses for certificate students. Acceptance in the Energy Commerce certificate is subject to approval by the Energy Commerce area coordinator.
