Students will take 5 courses related to the energy industry and upon graduation will receive a certificate in Energy Commerce in addition to the BBA degree in their major. Students will be required to have completed all lower division business core courses and have a minimum GPA of 3.0 by the start of the fall semester they take ENCO 3301 and ENCO 3385. Limited space is available in Energy Commerce courses for certificate students. Acceptance in the Energy Commerce certificate is subject to approval by the Energy Commerce area coordinator.
