

# BADMINTON SINGLES TOURNAMENT

When: Friday, February 17

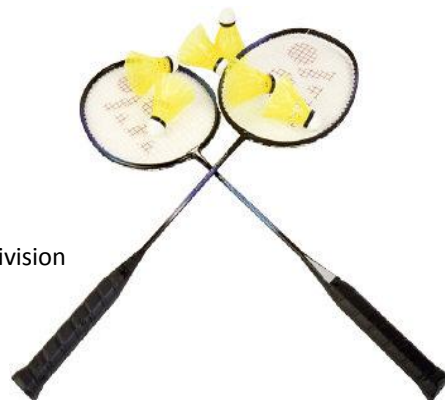
Where: Student Recreation Center, Court 3

Division: Singles:           Men's           Women's  
\*Players are only allowed to compete in men's or women's division

Play: Single elimination tournament.

How the Game is Played:

- Matches comprise of the best of three games. Each game starts at 0-0 (traditionally called "love-all").
- A coin is tossed before the first game, and the winner of the toss may serve first or pick an end of the court. Only the serving side can score.
- The winning team needs 15 points men's or 11 in women's singles.
- If the serving side wins a rally, it scores a point, and serves again but from the alternate service court. If the receiving side wins the rally, the score remains unchanged and the service passes to the next player in turn.
- In men's singles and doubles events, 15 points wins a game. However, if the score reaches 14-14, the side which first reached 14 can choose either to play to 15, or to set the game to 17 points. The final score will reflect the sum of the points won before setting plus the points gained in setting.
- Scoring in women's singles is slightly different. 11 points wins a game and there is the option to set to 13 points at 10-10.
