

# DODGEBALL TOURNAMENT

When: Friday, February 10<sup>th</sup> starting at 4pm

Where: Student Rec Center Court 5

Divisions: Open

Play: Single Elimination Tournament

Matches will be decided using a “best of five” format, in which the first team to win three (3) games will be declared the winner.



## **TEAMS**

Teams shall be made up of 6 players with a minimum of 3 players to start a match. Once “a game” starts no substitution will be allowed for ANY reason.

## **BOUNDARIES**

During play, all players must remain within the boundary lines. Players may leave the boundaries only to retrieve stray balls.

This game is played using the “**HONOR SYSTEM**”. Players will be expected to rule whether or not a hit was legal or illegal. Arguing is NOT allowed. If this occurs, players will be asked to leave the playing area. Here is a good rule for dodge ball:

## DODGEBALL ‘OUT’ SCENARIOS

**\*\*The ball becomes dead once it hits the ground or the wall\*\***

- If a player is hit with a ball, the player hit is out
- If a ball is caught by an opposing player, the thrower is out
- If a ball thrown is knocked down by a ball held by the opposing player, no one is out
- If a ball thrown is knocked down by a ball held by the opposing player then hits the opposing player, no one is out. As long as the thrown ball hits the held ball first

- If a ball thrown is knocked down by a ball held by the opposing player then caught in the air by a teammate, the thrower is out
- If a ball thrown contacts an opposing player and is then caught in the air by a teammate, the thrower is out and the original hit person is safe
- If a ball thrown contacts an opposing player, then hits the wall, the ball is dead and the contacted person is out. Catching the ball does not apply once the ball hit the wall
- If a ball thrown contacts an opposing player and a teammate touches the ball but fails to catch it, the hit player and teammate are both out.
- If a ball thrown is knocked down by a ball held by the opposing player then a teammate touches the ball but fails to catch it, the teammate that attempted the catch is out.
